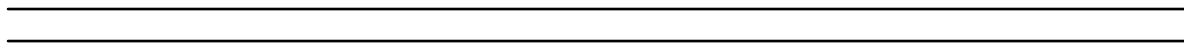
As promised or sort of stick to the plan this newsletter is the first of a series of newsletters which will explain the workings of radionics, I do believe that any one that plans to work with a radionics machine should at least be able to explain to someone else how or why it works. In the workshops we normally do I make a point of explaining the concept as complete as possible.

I will keep it down to earth and try to make it not too technical or complex to understand. If there is any point or part you would like more info on please let me know and we will explain or discuss it in future issues.

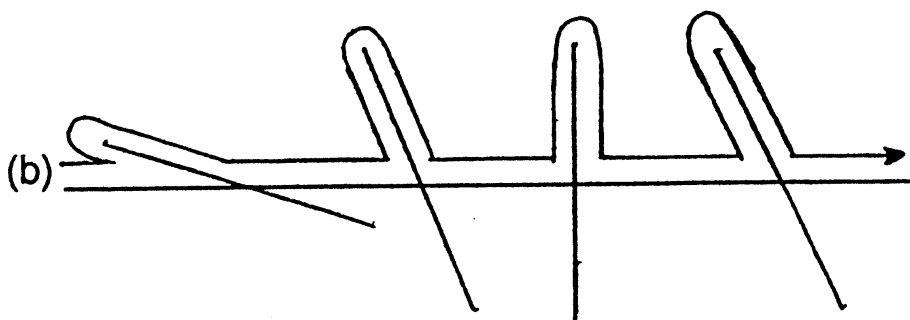
The most often asked question I get is what is the difference between the different bases (Base 10, Base 336 and Base 44).

Well about two thousand rands would be my normal reply, but no there is a more simple but yet a complex answer to it. But for me to explain that I first need to give you an idea how it works then you will see that there is really nothing to it.

If we look at the dials all set on zero they will form a linear line and energy will flow through undisputed



But the moment there is any change in the dials it will disrupt the flow of energy and thus create a ripple effect which can be seen as a three dimensional pattern at the end of the line



So to get back to the what is the difference between the bases it is the angle or degree at which the line is cut. Thus were there is big spaces between the numbers on a Base 10 and 336 the ones on a Base 44 is much closer thus the angle at which the linear line is cut is much more refined than that of the Base 10 and 336. Which makes the base 44 much more accurate or refined in its energy output. Which makes the Base 44 much better in my book than any other base (not that there is anything wrong with them). Maybe I must tackle the second most often asked question while we are trying to explain how the dials work. That is the purpose of the numbers on the dials well this is simply

reference points. The numbers on the dial allow you to make a certain selection which mean that you can always go back to the same settings.

The third most common question I get from the more technical minded people is on the resistance of the pots. To give a simple answer to that, the resistance play no role in the actual workings of the machine. In Abrams (the father of radionics) time he had belief that it is all about resistance and had work his "rates" out in ohms. It worked but it only cover one part of a bigger picture, there is actually three parts to it; 1.resistance 2. current and 3. conductivity all three of these form the totality of the radionic rate.

Well let me be a spoil sport and say let us leave that for the next newsletter because it need more space to explain.
